 <i>A Fresh, crisp dry white with flavours of gooseberry and citrus with a touch of flintiness typical of the bordeaux region</i></p> |
| 56 | <p>Semillon/Sauvignon Moore's Creek Tyrrells 2009, Australia £15.50
 <i>Intense herby and citrus fruit aromas followed by good length of flavour with a zesty, citrus finish.</i></p> |

 <i>A gorgeous, classy white. A floral bouquet flows into pure pears, peaches and spice. The texture and finish have a lovely balance.</i></p> |

| 79 | <p>Castiglioni Chianti DOCG 2007, Italy (half bottle) £9.00
 <i>A medium bodied wine showing flavours of strawberries and cherry on the nose, followed by hints of herbs and spice on the palate and a richness of fruit and tannins. A well-balanced, structured wine.</i></p> |
| 27 | <p>Carignan 'Vieilles Vignes' Mont Rocher 2009, France £15.25
 <i>Made from 40 year old vines, this has elegant dark fruits on the nose with a charming mix of moreish sweet fruit, clove spices and mellow tannins on the palate.</i></p> |
| 26 | <p>Pinotage The Ruins 2009, South Africa £17.00
 <i>Medium structured with sweet black cherry, coffee and white spice flavours and smooth persistent tannins</i></p> |
| 28 | <p>Le Fou Pinot Noir 2008, Languedoc £18.75
 <i>A luscious, textural Pinot Noir made without oak, displaying very intense sweet berry fruit with a savoury twist and a long, sensuous finish</i></p> |
| 25 | <p>Malbec Chakana 2008, Argentina £19.00
 <i>Impressive concentration of dark ripe blackberries with hints of chocolate. Sheer magic with a juicy lump of steak!</i></p> |
| 29 | <p>Chianti Leonardo 2008, Italy £19.00
 <i>Fresh red fruits mingle with pepper and spice on the nose. Lively and fresh in the mouth with rounded tannins, attractive structure, good intensity and a long finish.</i></p> |
| 21 | <p>Côtes du Rhône Villages 'Les Coteaux' Boutinot 2007, France £19.50
 <i>Deliciously smooth and rich with elegant red berry fruits, soft supple tannins and a finish that lasts forever. A favourite!</i></p> |
